Criteria and Eligibility to Participate in the Postgraduate Course

Eligibility to Participate in the Course

- 1. At least 50% women
- 2. Experience in working on an early grade reading activity (such as RARA, EGRA, NEIPlus etc.)
- 3. Submit Proof of a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in education or related field (e.g. Hausa, English, Languages or Education)
- 4. Completed application form and provide all relevant supporting documents through postgraduate@crea-neiplus.com
- 5. First Cohort will give priority to partners from Bauchi, Sokoto or Abuja with the aforementioned experience.
- 6. Work experience in State or Federal Education Institutions or organizations (class teaching experience preferred)
- 7. The person must have active years of service and ready to add input on improving reading outcome in Nigeria.
- 8. The course will enroll up to 20 participants in a cohort. (5 alternates may likely be selected for each cohort).
- 9. Provide a letter from your institution/organization providing permission for you to be away from work to participate in the course.
- 10. Provide a letter indicating party to be responsible (personal responsibility) for all the shared cost component of the course to be covered by you.

Course Requirement

- 1. There is **no fee** associated with application, tuition or enrollment.
- 2. Person should have access to and will use email for communication.
- 3. Travel expenses and per diem (NATA) will not be provided by the project.
- 4. Person is responsible for my transportation to each week's class location (this will either be in Abuja, Bauchi or Sokoto **check on the timeline for interaction below**).
- 5. The locations for the class will be in Abuja, Sokoto, Bauchi, and Abuja. **
- 6. Class attendance is compulsory
- 7. A ten-page independent research paper is required.
- 8. Person is required to present at least three (3) PowerPoint presentations during the period.
- 9. Out-of-class readings, assignments, writings, and journals are required, including independent work that will take place between class session weeks.
- 10. Some assignments will be turned in via email between class weeks.
- 11. Participation in class discussions/feedback is required.
- 12. Person will provide a notebook, paper, writing implements, and will print articles, handouts, and other class materials as necessary.
